











Rosie Mudge Falling on my head like a memory 2020 Automotive Paint and Glitter Glue on Canvas 182 x 62 cm



Rosie Mudge Falling on my head like a new emotion 2020 Automotive Paint and Glitter Glue on Canvas 182 x 72 cm





ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Rosie Mudge was born in 1988 in Knysna, South Africa and currently lives and works in Cape Town, South Africa. She obtained her BAFA with distinction from the Michaelis School of Fine Art at the University of Cape Town. During her studies, she was awarded the Simon Gerson prize for excellence (2013 and 2012) and was selected to attend a symposium exchange for Masters students at Braunschweig University, Germany.

In 2019, Mudge took part in an international group exhibition and mini residency in Mauritius which included a diverse range of artists from Australia, India, Africa and Reunion, to name a few. Mudge has participated in numerous South African group exhibitions as well as the Cape Town and Joburg

Art Fairs. Her first solo exhibition, *In my room with Mazzy Star*, was with SMITH in 2018. More recently she presented her second solo exhibition namely *From My Balcony to Yours*, also with SMITH in 2020.

With an interest in curation, Mudge also cofounded Cubicle and Jnr, two transient project spaces, in Cape Town. In 2019, Mudge co-curated the collaborative duo show Two Trees with artist Sitaara Stodel. Later this year Mudge will be participating in a new collaborative duo-exhibition with Johannesburg based artist Mmabatho Grace Mokalapa in association with the transient project space, Gallery Gallery. Mudge also plans to explore some further curatorial projects.
